Saturday, December 17; Mastering the Rules of the Road

This seminar provides an explanation with examples of the 37 Rules of the Road for both the U.S. Inland Rules and the International Rules (COLREGS). It simplifies the sometimes complex law relating to boat operation for the recreational boater. It is a starting point for study preparation for the USCG License examination.

Thursday, January 12, Using a GPS

Sure, GPS can get you where you need to go, but did you know you can use it to steer your boat accurately? Enhance your boating experience by getting the most out of today's feature-packed GPS devices. Learn how to store and use waypoints, build and execute routes, and monitor steering. You can also get tips on connecting your GPS to your VHF marine radio, which opens up a new world of digital hailing and distress signaling.

Saturday, February 11, America's Boating Course

Skippers, spouses and family members come learn some basic boating safety. Topics covered include, Boat Handling, Docking, Aids to Navigation, State & Federal Regulations, Anchoring, Trailing Tips, Rules of the Road, Emergencies, PWC Safety, Knots and Splices. Upon successful completion of the exam a certificate will be awarded. SCDNR will also send you a boater education card. Cost for this all day class is \$50.00 for first family member and \$10.00 for each additional family member sharing the same book.
